Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope this letter finds you well as we head into the Christmas period. With lots to look forward to, I wanted to take a moment to look back and share with you some of the wonderful academic achievements by the children last year.

KS2 Outcomes

As you will know, in Year 6 the children take part in a national set of assessments called SATs. These assessments are designed to measure whether children are secondary ready when they reach the end of KS2. The children worked incredibly hard in the lead up to these assessments and we were delighted to see how well they had achieved.

In the 2024/25 academic year, **85%** of children met the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths (combined) which was a **25% increase** on the previous year and **'significantly above the national average' of 61%**. Added to this, just under **50% of children achieved the 'higher standard'** in Reading and Maths, and achieved a score significantly above what was expected. To meet the expected standard children are aiming for a scaled score of 100, the children **last year averaged a scaled score of 107.8**, further solidifying and recognising their hard work. In summary, the results achieved class both attainment and the progress children made as **'significantly above the national average'**.

Phonics

Every year in Year 1, the children take part in the statutory Phonics screening test to assess the children's phonics knowledge and skills. Last year, **86%** of children in Year 1 **met the required standard** which is **5%** above the national average with an **average score of 34** out of 40 (32 is the pass mark).

KS1 Outcomes

Although no longer a statutory requirement in Year 2, we opt to take part in the KS1 SATs assessments as a useful way to measure attainment. In 2024/25, **80%** of Year 2 children met the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths combined, **20% higher than the national** outcomes with an **average scaled score of 104** (100 = Expected), 2 higher than the national average. Broken down to individual subjects, **87% met the standard in Reading, 80% in Writing and 90% in Maths**.

Year 4 Multiplication Table Check

Finally, in the Summer Term Year 4 take part in a statutory Multiplication Table Check, where they are provided 25 random multiplication tables and they have 6 seconds to provide the answer with their first answer being accepted. In the 2024/25 academic year, **64% of children scored 100%** which was a **21% increase from last year**, **70% of children scored 96%** and above (24 out of 25) which was a **27% increase from last year** and **93% of children scored 92% or above** (23 out of 25) which was a **32% increase from last year**. The children did so well and their time with Times Table Rockstars really paid off.

I want to thank all the children and staff for their hard work during their assessments, but also to all the parents and carers who have spent time outside of school reading or helping prepare for the various assessment that have taken place, your support, as always, is greatly appreciated.
