Monday 15th December – 1.30pm

Children will already be in school. Doors will open at 1.15pm for adults who are coming to watch the performance.

Tuesday 16th December – 4pm

Children will stay in school and get ready in their costumes for a 4pm start. Doors will open at 3.45pm for parents coming to watch the show. Please can we ask parents supply a small snack for the children to eat between 3.15pm and the show starting.

As per last year, to ensure as many people can come to the performances, there will be a limit of 3 tickets per performance per family and there will be a waiting list in case any additional tickets become available.
